Graduation is an exciting time. It is both an ending and a beginning. It is a warm memory of the past and big dreams for the future".

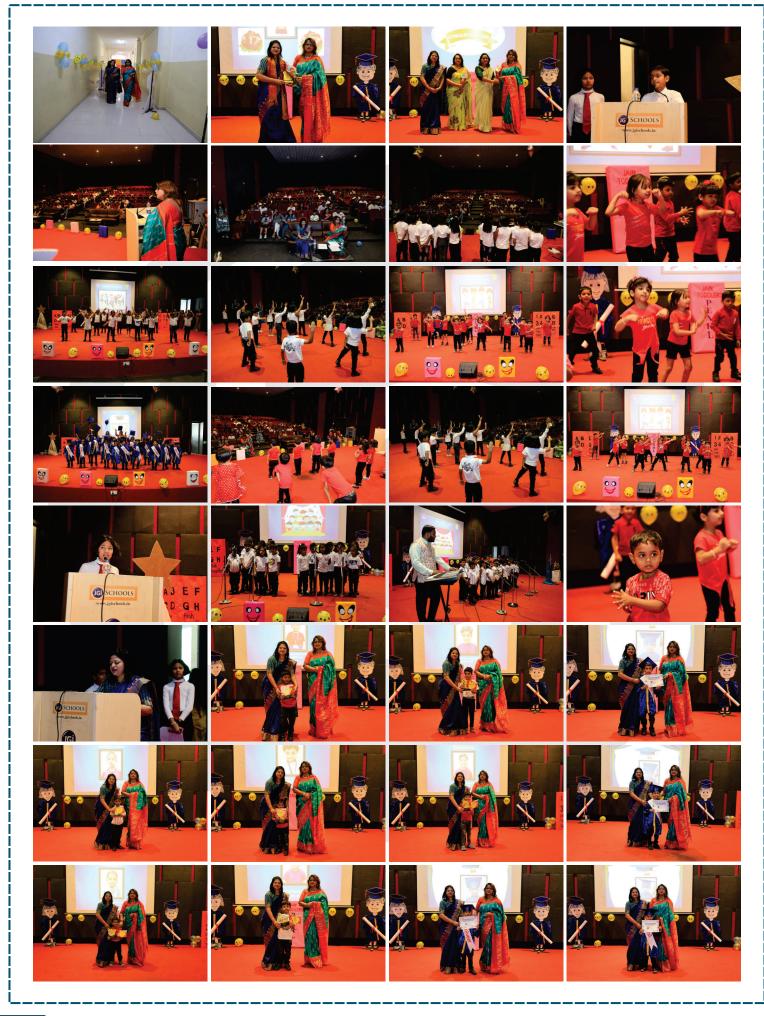

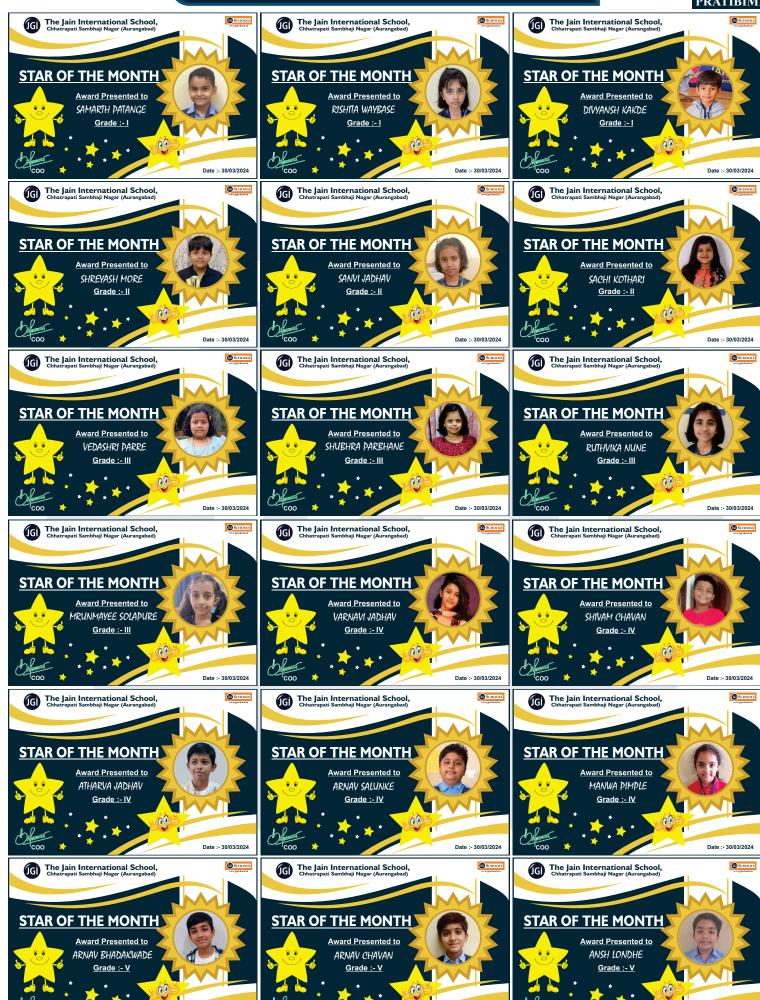
Heartiest congratulations dear Riya
