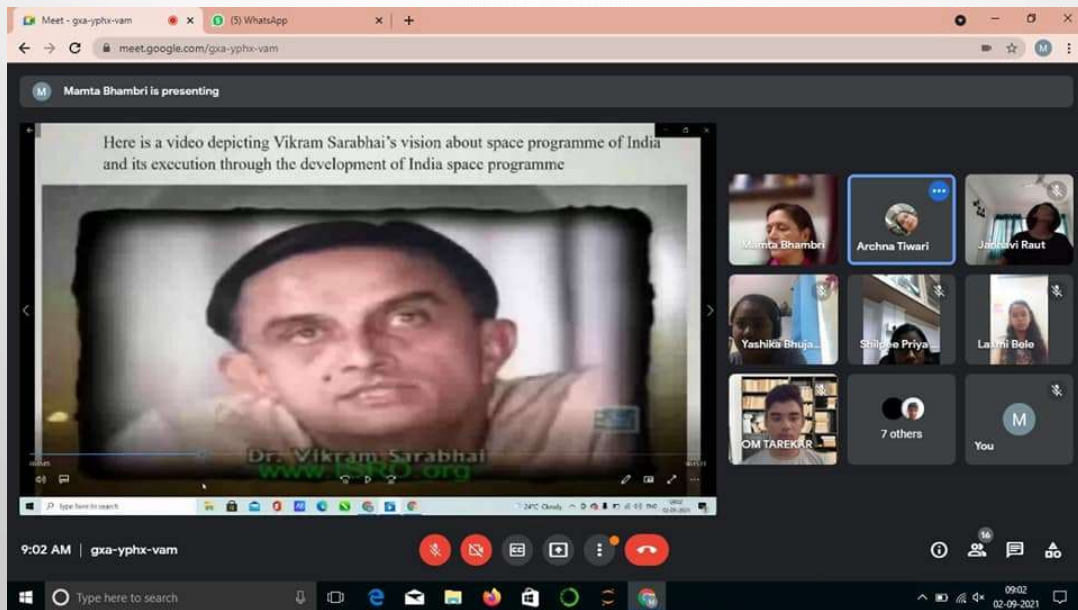
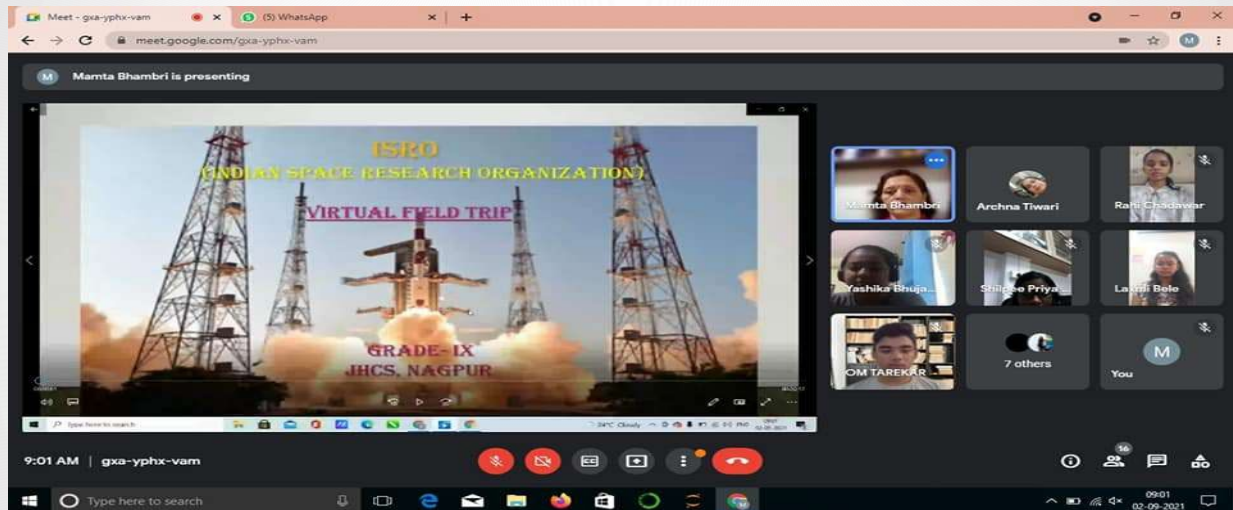

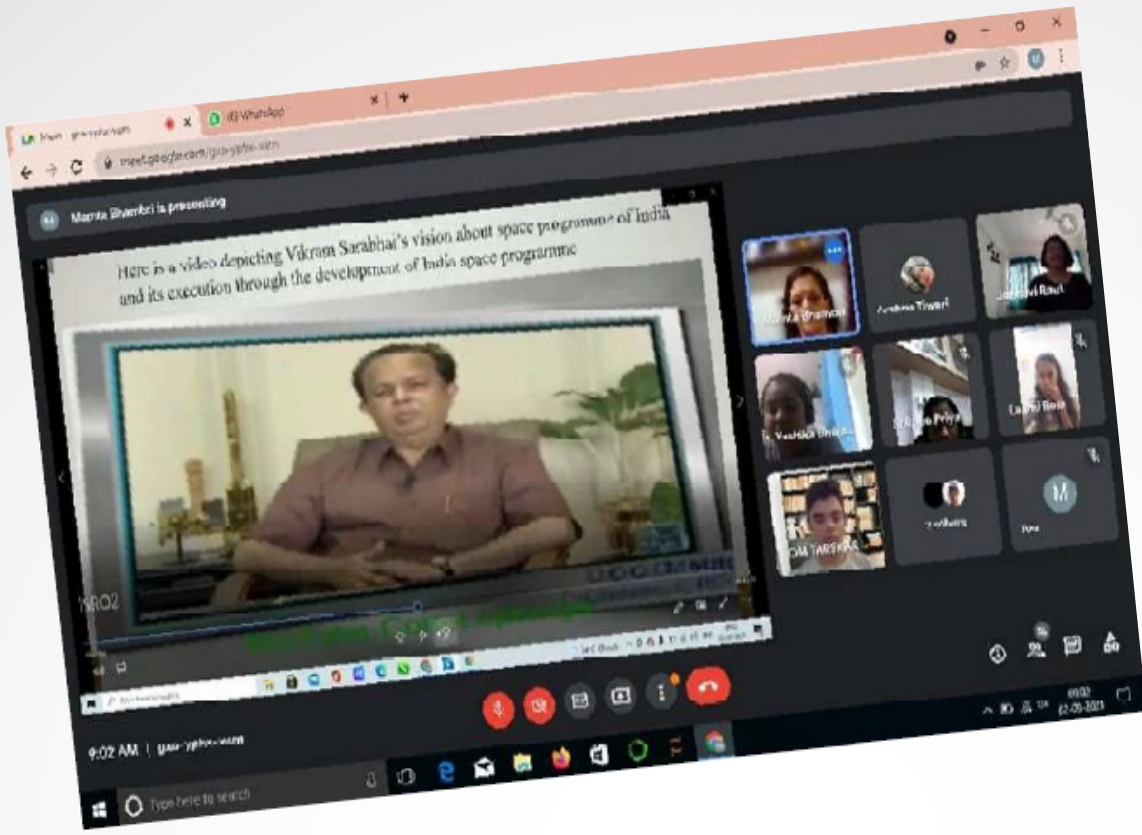
GRADE : IX - VIRTUAL FIELD TRIP TO ISRO

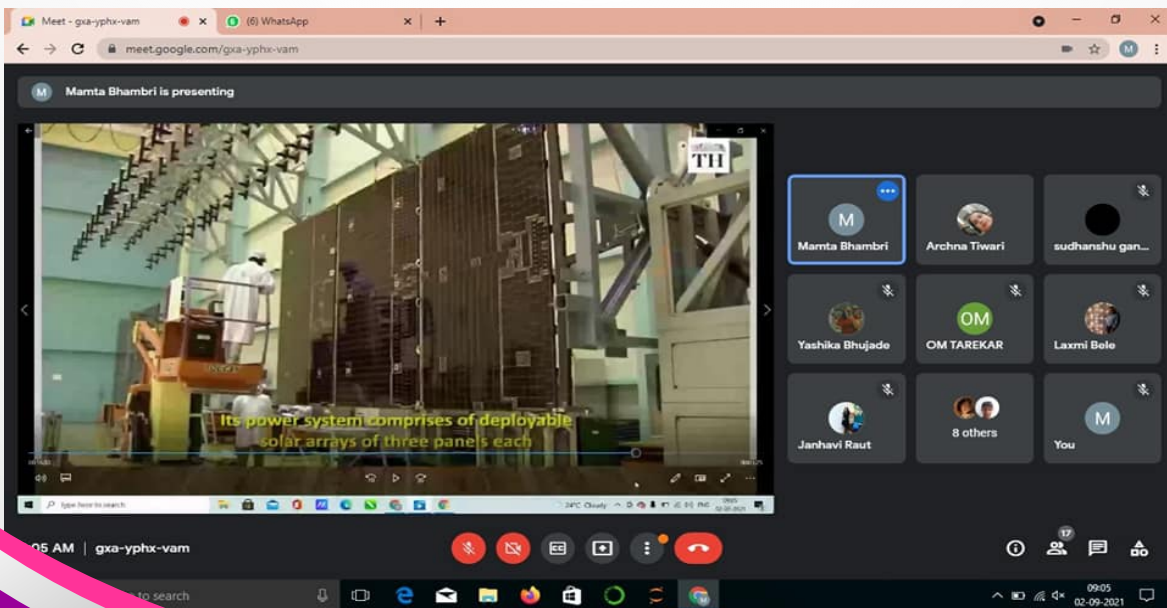
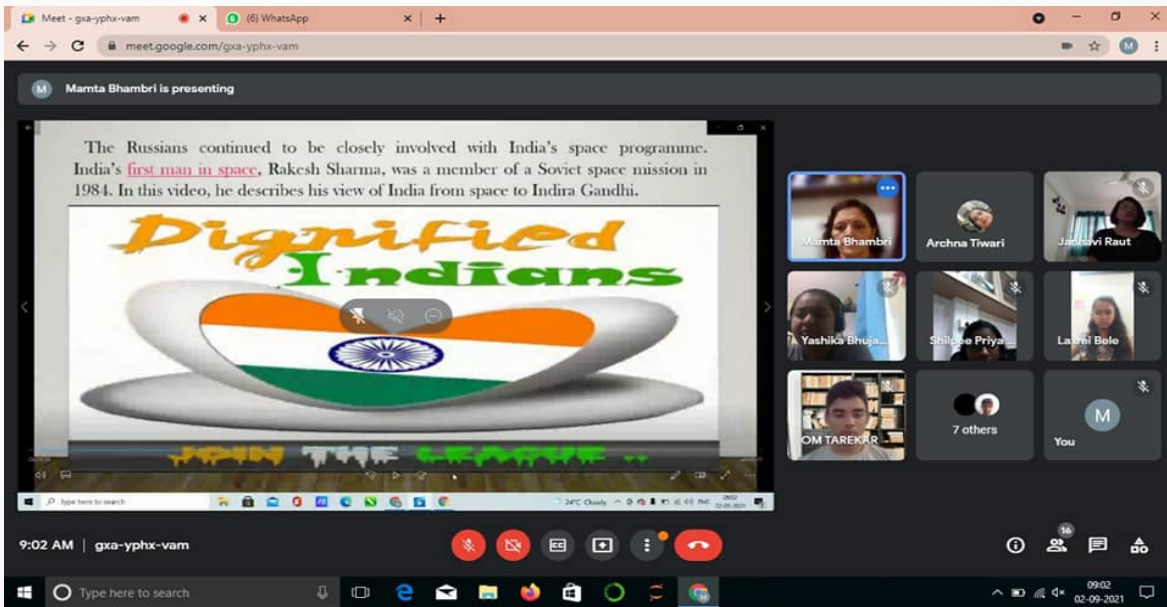
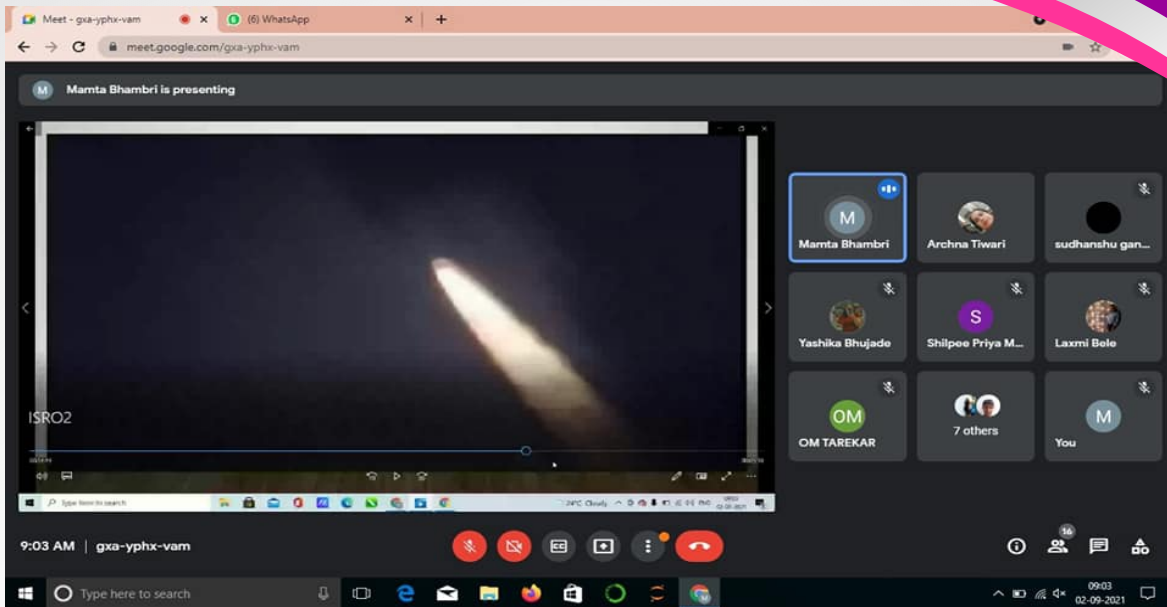

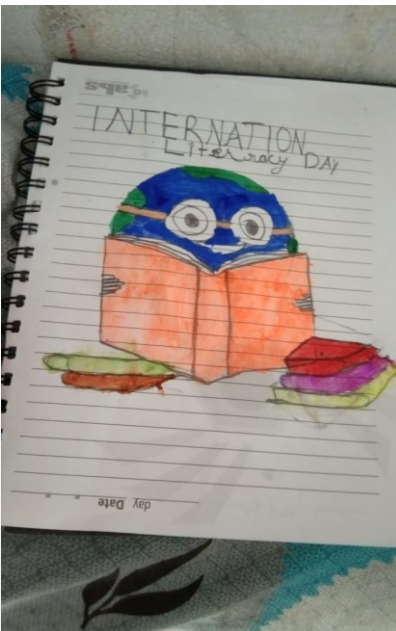


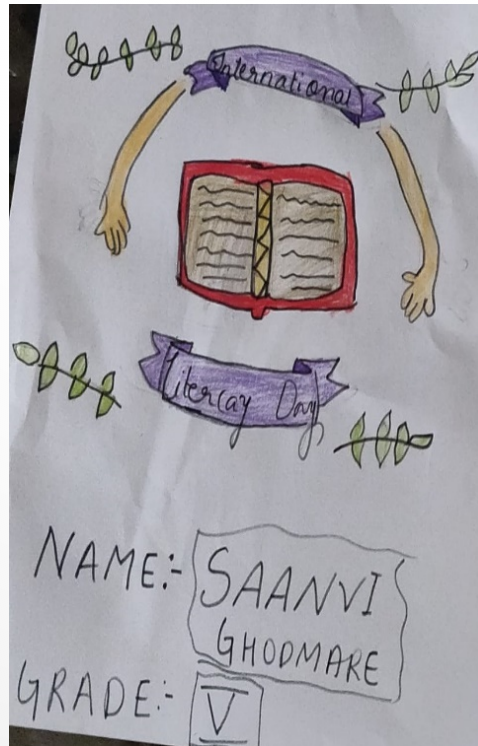
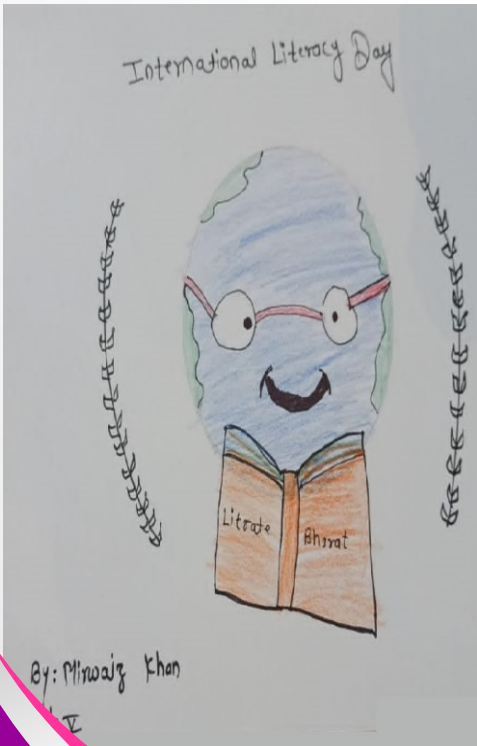
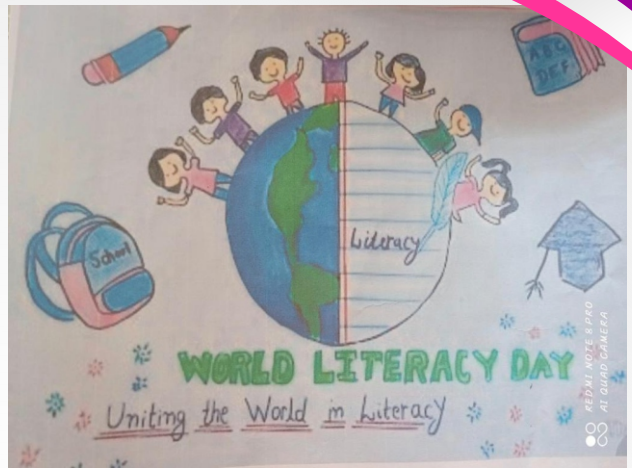
INTERNATIONAL LITERACY DAY

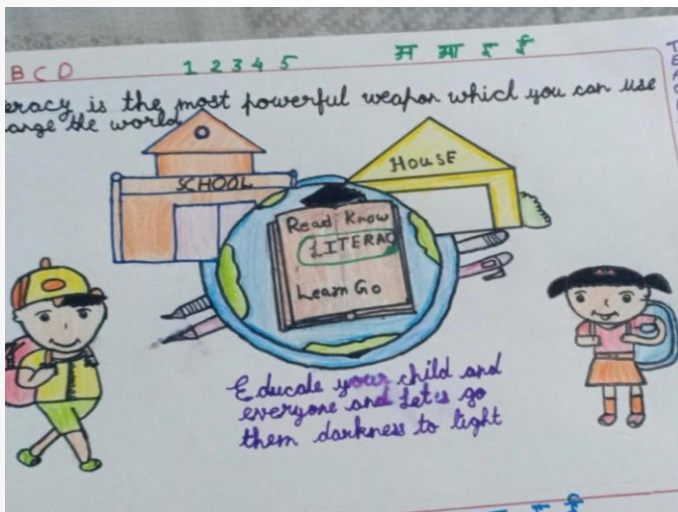

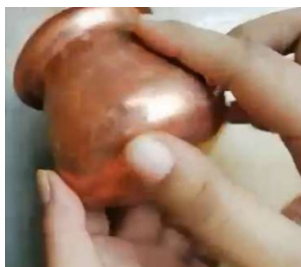


OBSERVATION

Lemon juice contains citric acid and these react with the basic layer of copper carbonate on the surface to form a soluble salt which is easily removed and the surface shines.

CONCLUSION

Citric acid present in lemon neutralises the basic layer of copper carbonate and dissolves the layer that's why copper vessels are cleaned with lemon and salt to give the surface of the vessel its characteristic lustre.
