The children of Grade IX of JHCS Nagpur have an excited virtual field trip to ISRO.




Virtual Teacher's Day Celebration @ JHCS Nagpur




INTERNATIONAL LITERACY DAY



Students of grade V of JHCS Nagpur dressed as various Educationist Reformers on the occasion of International Literacy Day.
























































GANESH CHATURTHI CELEBRATION







Results of teaching:



Each student participated enthusiastically and learned the importance of Hindi language.
























































CROSSWORD PUZZLE










GRADE: VI - VIRTUAL FIELD TRIP TO THE OCEAN
