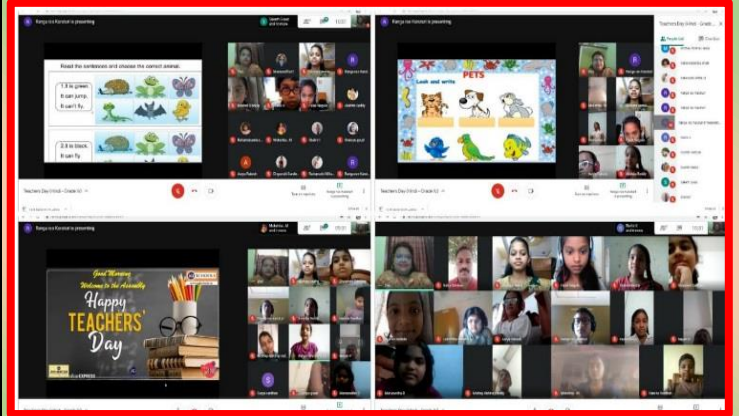

The assembly was theme based, well planned and carefully conducted under the able guidance of Grade 8 class teacher.

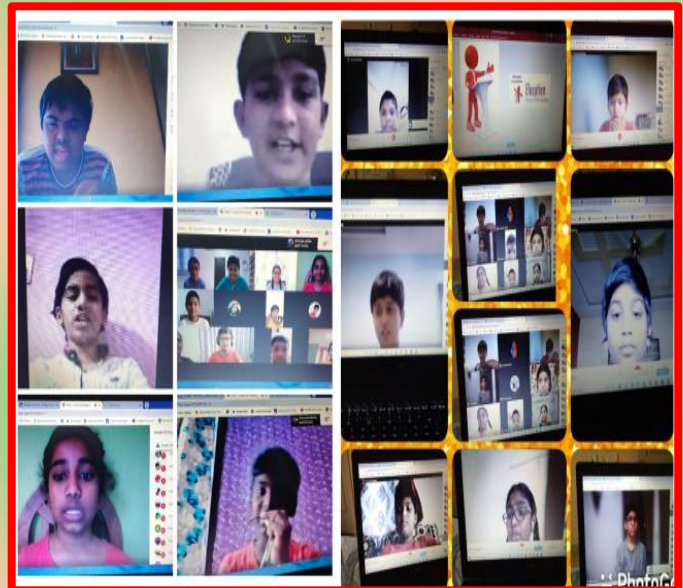

The main aim of the Teacher to conduct the Talk Show is to motivate and explore their inner selves of tiny tots and to develop their language skills.

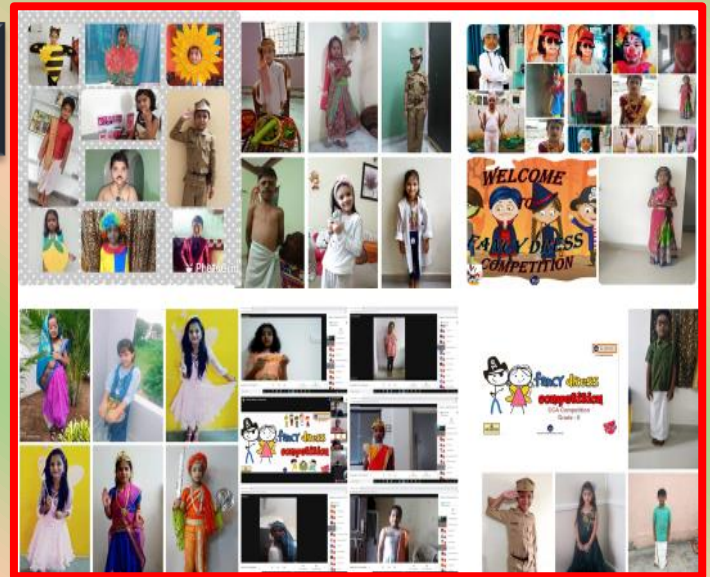

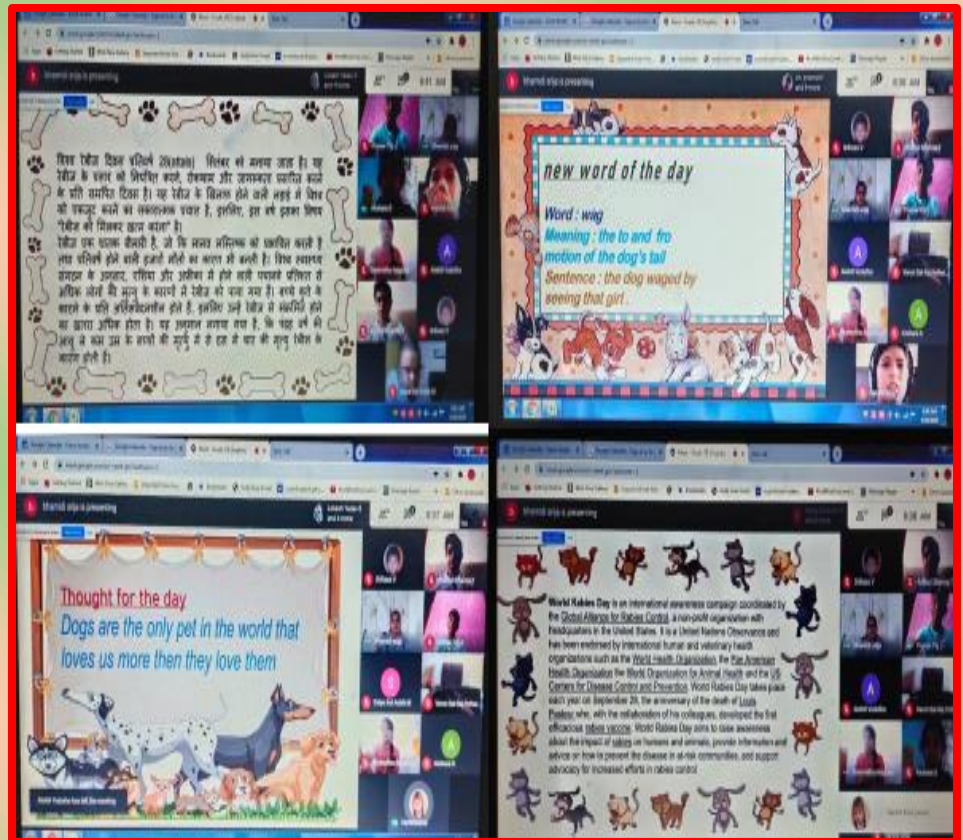
Special Assembly Presentation on “World Rabies Day”
