


# World Zoonoses Day

World Zoonoses Day is celebrated annually every July 6.

On July 6, 1885, French biologist Louis Pasteur successfully administered the first rabies vaccine to a little boy bitten by a rabid dog. The vaccine not only prevented the child from getting rabies; it saved his life.

Rabies is just one example of many zoonotic diseases. Avian influenza, Ebola, and the West Nile Virus are some examples. Zoonotic pathogens can be viral, bacterial, or parasitic and can spread to humans through direct contact or indirectly through food, water, or the environment. It may even spread through an intermediary species. It does not just originate from wild animals like bats or monkeys.



It can also come from pets and farm animals. The use of antibiotics in animals raised for food increases the potential for drug-resistant strains of zoonotic pathogens.

Paper bags can be used again and again with careful process. So, let's make our planet healthier and go with paper bags.



On July 26, 1999, the Indian Army recaptured all the military posts in Kargil that had been occupied by Pakistani troops and militants. In honour of the Army's successful mission (called Operation Vijay), July 26 is celebrated as Kargil Vijay Diwas every year.
